Digital Inclusion Maturity Model Program

G3ict deploys a Smart **Enterprise Maturity Model®** for companies and Cities. Each tool defines key performance indicators and metrics supporting accessibility and inclusion. G3's Maturity Model tools support the development of roadmaps and strategies to grow and mature commitment to and capabilities on inclusion and accessibility. With the support and strategic partnerships, this suite of maturity model tools is a great way to start or continue working towards inclusion.

The Navigator ™ Criteria Tool

The Navigator is a Tool developed by a disability-led business inclusion implementation program. The Navigator is part of G3's Disability Inclusion & Accessibility Criteria (DI&AC) Program. The DI&AC Program is governed by a Disability Advocacy Steering Committee aiming to support organizational disability inclusion through tools, coaching, training, and a robust resource library.

DARE Index

The Digital Accessibility Rights Evaluation (DARE) Index 2020 is a benchmarking tool developed by G3ict for disability advocates, governments, civil society, international organizations, and policymakers to trace the country's progress in making ICT accessible in compliance with Article 9 of the CRPD. The Index documents the advances made by 137 countries among the 182 States Parties to the CRPD.

DARE Scholarship Fund

DARE is a program dedicated to opening new potential for persons with disabilities who are interested in advocating for digital accessibility and getting certified as professionals.

Smart Cities for All (SC4A)

E-Accessibility Toolkit for Persons with Disabilities
