M-Enabling Summit 2023

Event Space Description

Renaissance Arlington Capital View Hotel event space spans over 20,000 square feet and is located on the 2nd floor of the hotel. The event space can be accessed by elevators to the left of the 1st-floor reservation desk or by a flight of stairs to the left of the elevators. The stairs only go up to the second floor, so once you reach the top, you are on the second floor and the event area.

The registration and accessibility desks are to the left if you get off the elevators or straight in front of you if you take the stairs.

From the registration desk with your back to the registration desk, there are four primary directions you can explore: Straight forward, left, right, and right then right.

Straight Forward.

Straight in front of you are two exhibit booths. Turning right past the exhibit booths and then left - are the stairs, and Studio-C is to the right of the stairs.

Please note the exhibit booths are only open on Tuesday, the 10th, and Wednesday, the 12th.

With your back to the registration desk, you pass the accessibility desk on your left, and elevators are straight ahead on your right. The elevators are close, around 15 feet walking distance, located in a short hallway. The elevator doors will be on your right.

Turning left.

If you turn left from the Registration desk, you pass the Accessibility desk. Studio A will be on your left, and Studio B will be on your right. One or two exhibitors will be in the hallway. The hallway will have ample space to navigate around. The separate bathrooms for women and men are at the end of the hall. You will take a slight right, the women on the right, and the men on the left.

Booth Number(s) T1 & T-2

Turning right then taking another right.

If you turn right from the registration desk, you will pass two or three booths on your right (Booths 4,5 & 6). There is a support beam in front of you. If you stay right off the beam and pass the booth on the right, you can make a right into one of the pre-function hallways. A couple of booths will be on your left, but most will be on your right. You can also access Salon 1 and 2 on your left. The Salons will host additional exhibitors.

The event photo booth set up for professional headshots is at the end of the hallway. If you are interested, check out the time on the agenda and stop by.

Booth Number(s): 7,8,9 & 10

Turning right.

If you turn right from the registration desk and stay left of the support beam, your head down the primary pre-function hallway. On this hallway, you will notice exhibit booths on your right to the end of the hallway. You will also locate Studio-D and Studio-E on your left. Across from Studio D and Studio E is the main ballroom, where all the general sessions will occur. There are three doors leading into the main ballroom.

At the end of the hallway, past the ballroom, there is another hallway on your right. All rooms are on the left, starting with the event Boardroom, Studio F, and the separate men's and women's bathroom. On the right side of the hallway are doors that take you into the main ballroom.

Booth Number(s): T-5, T-6, T-7. Booths 12, 13, 14,15 & 16

Rooms Layout & Configurations

Ballroom

The main ballroom will host round tables throughout the room with rows of chairs in the front and on the back wall. A main walkway will lead to the front stage if you enter the room across from Studio E. If you're facing the stage, there are stairs on the left to access the stage. The accessible ramp access is on the right of the stage. If you want to use the accessible ramp to get on stage, enter the ballroom through the doors across from Studio D. This way, you will not need to weave around the round tables.

Studio's

Each of the Studio's layouts will include a classroom setting. Chair spaces will be left open for people who use wheelchairs. All Studies will be set up with a table in the front for panel presentation. There will be a room facilitator and a door person.
