M-ENABLING SUMMIT REACHES NEW MILESTONE AND HEIGHTENED INTEREST IN ACCESSIBLE TECHNOLOGY

BETHESDA, MD (June 22, 2017) – "Making Connected Things and Services Accessible for All" was the key theme of the 6th annual **M-Enabling Summit** held in Washington, DC June 12-14, 2017. The **M-Enabling Summit** was once again the host of the 2017 awards ceremony for the FCC Chairman's Awards for Advancement in Accessibility (Chairman's AAA). FCC Chairman Ajit Pai keynoted Tuesday afternoon's plenary session. The Awards recognized outstanding private and public-sector ventures designed to advance accessibility for people with disabilities. Winners and honorable mentions included Facebook, Amazon, Teach Access, Aira Teach, and Ava App.

Key sessions and topics that were highlighted this year at the **M-Enabling Summit** included: accessibility for better branding, social media and collaborative platforms, innovation in robotics, wearables, virtual and augmented reality, artificial intelligence, IoT, smart homes and appliances, as well as scaling-up accessibility in higher education, businesses, government, workplaces, and smart cities.

As the mobile market continues to expand at a rapid pace, the need for accessible solutions continues to climb. Accessibility has become a key factor in ICT innovation, offering new growth opportunities. The next **M-Enabling Summit** will be held June 18-20, 2018 in Washington, DC.
